

# DEA announces change to registration renewal

November 11, 2016

On November 7, 2016, the United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) announced a change to their registration renewal process. Effective January 1, 2017, the DEA will send only one renewal certification to the “mail to” address for each DEA registrant approximately 65 days prior to the expiration date. With this change, the DEA will not send any reminder notifications to any registrant.

As part of this change, DEA registration renewal will no longer be available online after the expiration date of a license. If a license has expired, DEA registrants must apply for a new DEA registration.
